PSYCHONEUROIMMUNOLOGY

Psychoneuroimmunology (PNI) is a field of research which has shown a link between the brain and the immune system. Research seems to indicate that 1) contact with others contributes to health and longevity; 2) sharing your feelings may also have positive benefits; 3) optimism is a strong health factor; and 4) loving relationships may help to keep us well. Of course not everyone is a believer. Many scientists remain skeptical. But, to the student of the Bible, none of this is very surprising.

Solomon wrote: "A merry heart maketh a cheerful countenance: but by sorrow of the heart the spirit is broken" (Proverbs 15:13). "All the days of the afflicted are evil: but he that is of a merry heart hath a continual feast" (Proverbs 15:15). "A merry heart doeth good like a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones" (Proverbs 17:22).

How we think does have a bearing on how we feel. We may not completely understand the relationship between attitude and good health, but it does exist. It was also Solomon who advised: "Keep thy
